


## Blue Train "A Window to the Soul of South Africa"

Food and beverages are always available with brunch served between 10:30 -14:30 and afternoon tea at 15:30. The route to Cape Town will make a late afternoon stop in Kimberley where a scheduled tour will take guests to the Open Mine Museum. The diamond rush started in 1871 and Cecil Rhodes the founder of De Beers was one of many hopeful entrepreneurs. The rush was on and after 43 years a hand dug hole of 463 metres wide and 240 metres deep was created, hence called "The Kimberly Big Hole".



The morning brings a picturesque view of the mountainous Western Cape and rolling vineyards of the wine lands. After breakfast you will start your next journey into Cape Town, the "Mother City".
